Maths

This week we will continue to learn all about money. Complete one Oak Academy lesson per day.

Challenge:

Task 1: Set up your own shop at home. Find a few different items that you will sell at your shop. Give each of your items a value less than 50p. If I wanted to buy an item from your shop and I paid with a 50p coin, what change would you give me? What coins would you use to give me change?

Task 2: Have a go at the 2Dos set on Purple Mash this week to help consolidate your understanding of money.


Additional Writing Task - The Tiger Child

Task 1: Listen to the story on Espresso (log in using details below, type The Tiger Child into the search bar). Design a collage of the tiger from the story, you could use different paper, paints, pencils etc. Be as creative as you can, we look forward to seeing your creations.

Task 2: Think of 5 adjectives to describe the tiger from the story. Write your adjectives around your collage creation.

Task 3: Create a story map of the story, you can do this using the story map template on PurpleMash or by doing the 'sequence the story' activity on espresso.

Task 4: Complete a book review on the book The Tiger Child. You can use the 2Do on PurpleMash as a template.


Practise some of your tricky words by singing this [song](#). Our tricky words for this week: **looked** and **asked**. Can you put our tricky words into sentences?
