


Remote-learning

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This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 1 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for remote-learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

Maths
This week we will be recapping place value to 100. Complete one Oak Academy lesson per day in the following order:


Additional Writing Task
Task 1: Have a think, what are you looking forward to doing in the summer holiday. Write a list of what you are looking forward to e.g. going to the park, baking, colouring etc.
Task 2: Can you put some of the things on your list into a sentence e.g. I am looking forward to going to the park.

Phonics:
Recap your phase 3 sounds by watching this [video](#). This week we are looking at 'ai', 'ay' and 'a_e', watch this [video](#) to recap these sounds. Then see if you can find any of these in one of your story books/food packaging or on items around the house. Practise some of your tricky words by singing this [song](#). This week we are recapping the tricky words **there** and **their**. Can you put our tricky words into sentences?

Reading:
Pick a story book from home or one from Bug Club. Why did you pick this book? What do you think this book is going to be about? Halfway through the book stop reading and make a prediction about how you think the story will end, you could even draw a picture of your prediction just like we do at school. Then carry on reading and see if your prediction was right.
