This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year Reception for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for remote learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

### Number, shape & measures:

**Number of the week: 6.** Watch [Numberblocks](#).

Can you draw six spots and count out six objects?

What is one more and one less than 6?

### Shape of the week

Did you know a square is a 2D shape?

Can you count how many corners and sides it has? Can you find objects at home which have the same shape?

### Representing and Comparing

Create two tracks on the carpet by laying out A4 pieces of paper.

Have numbers 1-3 prepared either on a dice or paper.

Ask one team to roll the dice and then collect that amount of counters. Place the counters on the A4 pieces of paper (one counter to one piece of paper). After each team has had their first turn compare who has the most / fewest. Ask how many counters they need to fill their track and win. **Send a picture of your objects to your teacher using evidence me.**



### The World / topic

**Irresistible Learning Topic:** Bonfire Night
