Number, shape & measures:


Number of the week: 6. Watch Numberblocks.

Representing and Comparing

Create two tracks on the carpet by laying out A4 pieces of paper.

Have numbers 1-3 prepared either on a dice or paper.

Ask one team to roll the dice and then collect that amount of counters. Place the counters on the A4 pieces of paper (one counter to one piece of paper). After each team has had their first turn compare who has the most / fewest. Ask how many counters they need to fill their track and win. Send a picture of your objects to your teacher using evidence me.
