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This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Nursery for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for remote learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week. Please send us any photos of the activities you do through "Evidence Me"

<p><u>Number, shape & measures:</u></p>  <p>Number of the Week: 2 Watch: Numberblocks</p> <p>Show 2 fingers. Which body parts do we only have 2 of? [eyes, ears, legs, arms etc] See if you can write the number 2.</p> <p><u>Counting fish:</u></p> <p>Draw or print off some fish, of differing amounts between 1 and 5 (up to 10 if your child is confident up to or beyond this number.) Can your child count how many fish they have? Give them different amounts. Write out some numbers on pieces of paper. Can your child match the numeral to the correct amount?</p> <p><u>Shape of the Week:</u> </p> <p>What things can you find at home that are a square shape? Can you try and draw a square? How many sides does it have? How many corners?</p>	<p><u>Communication, language & literacy</u></p> <p>Word of the Week: Rainbow</p> <p><u>Reading</u> We are sharing the story of The Rainbow Fish this week. Listen to the story together The Rainbow Fish. How does the rainbow fish feel at different parts of the story? Why is it important to share? How did he feel at the end of the story?</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> We are now learning a sound a week. This week we are learning the sound 'a'. Listen to this Jolly phonic 'a' song. See if you can do the action and say the sound. Can you think of anything that begins with 'a' sound? [ant, apple, astronaut, alligator.] Have a look for some objects around your house that begin with the 'a' sound. You can also watch this Scrap's phonics video on Espresso to help you learn.</p> <p><u>Writing/Mark Making:</u> See if your adult can draw a fish outline for you and see if you can trace over the top and draw some colourful patterns on it. Now, can you draw some wavy lines for the sea?</p>
<p><u>Irresistible Learning Topic: Make a Rainbow: Colours</u></p> <p><u>Colour- Rainbow</u></p> <p><u>Media and Materials:</u> See if you can decorate a rainbow fish. Ask your adult to draw an outline of a fish, or use a paper plate if you have one, and then you can use celery dipped in paint, crayons or cut circles out of coloured paper to decorate it.</p>  <p><u>Understanding of the World</u></p> <p>On Espresso, watch the 'Sea Animals' video to find out a bit more about some creatures that live in the sea.</p>	<p><u>Wellbeing-</u></p> <p>What things make you feel happy? Can you draw a smiley/happy face?</p> <p>What things are you looking forward to doing again when you can?</p>  <p>Have a go at this Freeze Dance activity to keep active and as a bit of fun.</p>
