





Communication, language & literacy
Word of the Week: Blue
Reading We are sharing the story of [Kipper: Splosh](#) this week. Listen to the story together. What did Kipper do? Who did he meet? Can you remember and say any of the words used in the story?
Phonics Session 1 Rhythm and Rhyme- Listen to this nursery rhyme [Incy wincy spider](#) see if you can join in. There are some words in it that rhyme spout/out, rain/again. They have the same end sound and sound very similar. Can you hear any rhyming words in this rhyme? [1, 2, 3, 4, 5, Once I caught a fish alive](#) [five/alive, ten/again, go/so, bite/right]
Session 2 This week we are learning the sound 'c and k' Listen to this song [Jolly phonic song ck](#) see if you can do the actions and say the sound. These two letters make the same sound but look different. Can you think of anything that begins with 'c'? [cat, cup, cot] and 'k' [kite, key, kangaroo] Have a look for some objects around your house that begin with 'c' and 'k'. Your adult can tell you which c/k sound it is.
