Year 1 – Week 4 – Weekly Activities

Topic (History/DT)

This week we are learning about the history of the seaside. British families have been visiting the seaside for many years for their holidays. What do you think it would have been like over 100 years ago? With an adult, if you can, use the internet to research how the seaside has changed over the years.

In our school we have lots of toys for you to play with. In the past, toys were very different. Children didn't have computer games or toys with batteries. One common toy was the cup and ball. Science - Environment
