This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 1 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for remote-learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

Maths

This week it is all about place value. First, watch this <u>video</u> to see how we can count to 50 by making groups of 10. Then complete the following Oak Academy lessons. There are optional worksheets set on PurpleMash for you to complete to help consolidate your understanding of place value within 50. Oak Academy:

Lesson 2: Grouping and counting in tens

Lesson 3: Exploring tens and ones Lesson 4: Introducing place value

Lesson 5: Using place value with numbers to 50

Challenge:

Task 1: Have a go at the Sequence Snake 2Do on Purple Mash. Can you guide the snake to the correct number? **Task 2:** Use a ball or a rolled-up pair of socks to throw to a partner. See how many times you can do this without dropping the ball. Can you reach 50? Count your score as you go!

Mental fluency:

Have a go at the <u>caterpillar ordering game</u> – can you order numbers to 20 correctly? Can you challenge yourself with numbers to 100? Practise your Rolling Numbers x2 x5 and x10 - show or teach someone in your house!

Irresistible Learning - Plants

This week are going to be learning all about the parts of a plant. Can you name any of the plant parts already? Is there an exciting fact you know about plants?

Use this <u>video</u> to help you learn about the plant parts and their functions, there is even a little quiz underneath the video.

Task 1: To support the first part of your learning this week we

would like you to complete the 2Do's set on PurpleMash all about labelling the plant parts.

Task 2: For the second part of your learning this week we would like you to get creative and draw a plant of your own, you can use pencils, paint, felt pens or anything else. After you have drawn your plant can you then correctly label all the plant parts? As a challenge can you write


Additional task: As an additional task this week, why not try to plant your very own seed and watch it grow. You don't even need a garden!

Phonics:

Recap your phase 3 sounds by watching this video.

This week we are learning two new sounds. Click on the links to learn our new sounds <u>au</u> and <u>ey.</u>Can you spot either of these sounds on packaging /labels around your home?

Practise some of your tricky words by singing this <u>song</u>. Our tricky words for this week: **oh** and **Mrs.** Can you put our tricky words into sentences?

Reading:

Read a book from <u>bug club</u> or one of your story books at home – what was your favourite part of the book and why?
